

Enchanting Cavaliers Health Guarantee/Contract

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The seller certifies that the puppy you purchase is in sound health at the time of sale to the best of our knowledge and you as the buyer(s) have been provided a veterinarian health summary that includes all vaccinations, wormings, and microchip designation. We have done our best to provide you, the new owner, with a happy, healthy puppy. You as the new owner will become responsible for further vaccination, boosters and wormings. You are required to have this puppy seen by your veterinarian within seven (7) business days of taking possession of the puppy. If this puppy becomes sick or has a genetic defect, the following stipulations must be adhered to in order for a replacement to be made. An official report from a licensed veterinarian stating, without doubt, the puppy has a genetic defect or health issue that would hinder the puppy's healthy growth to maturity. The information must include the phone number of that vet's office. If the puppy should die, an autopsy must be performed by a qualified licensed veterinarian with a written statement outlining the cause of death. The documentation must be forwarded to us to review before a determination is made. The seller reserves the right to confirm the diagnosis with a veterinarian of our choice. The seller will not be responsible for any expense you may incur, including return shipping and veterinary expenses.

This warranty applies only to the original buyer. Parasites are not covered under warranty as a puppy can pick these up over-night travel. Your puppy will be up to date on wormings and should be wormed regularly as recommended by your veterinarian.

Hernias, umbilical or inguinal, are occasionally present and maybe missed on health assessments performed when a puppy is under the care of the seller. If surgery is required, we provide reimbursement of \$50 for umbilical and \$75 for inguinal. Most will be outgrown, and if not, they can easily be repaired at the time of spaying/neutering. Spaying/neutering cost is the sole responsibility of the buyer.

We have raised this puppy from sound parents, and it is buyer's responsibility to take good care of him/her to ensure a long, health life. You play an important role in helping your puppy grow into a healthy adult.

If you as the buyer is unable to keep the dog or provide an appropriate home for the dog, the dog is to be returned to the seller. The buyer agrees to notify the breeder if any such contingency arises and will NOT abandon him/her to a shelter, sell, or give away the dog. The dog will be returned to the seller with it understood that any compensation will be at the sole discretion of the seller. If a dog is found to have been sold or given away without the seller's knowledge and written approval, the seller/breeder can take legal action to reclaim dog whereas the buyer will be responsible for all legal fees and expenses.

I, the seller, do hereby agree to offer a 30-day health and a one (1) year genetic warranty on this puppy as stated in the conditions above.
